António Manuel Dias Domingos graduated in Mathematics and Drawing (education) from the University of the Azores (1989). Master of Science of Education in the especialty of Education and Development (1995) and PhD in the same area, with the specialty of Curriculum Theory and Development (2005), both specializations conducted at the Faculty of Sciences and Technology, New University of Lisbon FCT-UNL.

Currently holds the post of Assistant Professor in the Department of Mathematics at FCT-UNL, teaching Curricular Units of the Master in Mathematics Teaching and the Doctoral Program in Educational Sciences in association with FCSH and ISPA.

It is researcher at UIED - Unit Research Education and Development, where he has participated in several funded research projects, among which stand out "Quality of learning in mathematics with the use of technological resources" (PTDC/CED/71744/2006) and "Promoting success in mathematics" (PTDC/CPE-CED/121774/2010), projects where he took over as Principal Investigator.

It is a member of various professional associations and incorporated the direction of the Association of Teachers of Mathematics (APM) and currently is a member of the Directorate of the Portuguese Society for Research in Mathematics Education (SPIEM).

The main research interests are linked to the issues related to the Teaching and Learning of Mathematics, the integration of Technologies in Teaching and Learning, Curriculum Development in Mathematics and aspects related to the History of Mathematics Teaching.
